24 in a fiscal year. The bill also allows a city with a
25 population of 2,500 or less to contract with a city officer or
26 employee for the purchase of goods or services by the city if
27 the total of such contracts with the officer or employee does
28 not exceed \$2,500 in a fiscal year.

29 Currently, any city is allowed to contract with a city

AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS OR SERVICES BY A CITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 362.5, subsection 10, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

10. Contracts not otherwise permitted by this section, for the purchase of goods or services by a city having a population of more than two thousand five hundred, which benefit a city officer or employee, if the purchases benefiting that officer or employee do not exceed a cumulative total purchase price of one thousand five hundred dollars in a fiscal year.

Sec. 2. Section 362.5, Code 1991, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 11. Contracts not otherwise permitted by this section for the purchase of goods or services by a city having a population of two thousand five hundred or less, which benefit a city officer or employee, if the purchases benefiting that officer or employee do not exceed a cumulative
