8 and recommendations for their reclassification based upon
9 present and future use.

10 (2) Methods for maintaining the biological diversity of
11 plants and plant life in state parks and preserves.

12 (3) Options to achieve controlled deer hunting in order to
13 prevent overpopulation of deer.

14 (4) Prevention of economic damage to private property
15 which is located adjacent to state parks and preserves.

16 The report shall be prepared in conjunction with the state
17 advisory board for preserves.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill requires the director of the department of
20 natural resources in conjunction with the state advisory board
21 for preserves to prepare a report before January 15, 1992, and
22 every two years thereafter, on the state's parks and
23 preserves. Topics to be included in the report are the
24 classification of the state's parks and preserves, the
25 diversity of plant life in the parks and preserves, the deer
26 population in the parks and preserves, and efforts by which
27 economic damage to private property adjacent to parks and
28 preserves can be prevented.

29 The report is to be submitted to the natural resource
30 commission and the general assembly.

RELATING TO REQUIRED REPORTING ON STATE PARKS AND PRESERVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

NEW PARAGRAPH. j. Submit a report to the natural resource commission before January 15, 1992, and every five years thereafter, which shall include but not be limited to information on the following topics:

- (1) The classification of the state's parks, recreation areas, and preserves and recommendations for their reclassification based upon present and future use.
- (2) Methods for maintaining the diversity of animal and plant life in state parks, recreation areas, and preserves.
- (3) Options to achieve controlled deer hunting in order to prevent overpopulation of deer.
- (4) Prevention of economic damage to private property which is located adjacent to state parks, recreation areas, and preserves.

The portion of the report dealing with preserves shall be prepared in conjunction with the state advisory board for preserves. A copy of the report shall be made available to members of the general assembly by sending a copy of the report to the chief clerk of the house of representatives, the
