17 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

18 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

19 Code section 303.1, subsection 2, paragraph "h" created the  
20 Iowa community cultural grants program and served to authorize  
21 its existence until 1990 when the program funding source was  
22 changed from lottery to general funds and the new multi-  
23 disciplined operational support grant program was created. At  
24 this time, new language was adopted which made section 303.1,  
25 subsection 2, paragraph "h" duplicative. As the language in  
26 section 303.3 more accurately outlines the programs, section  
27 303.1, subsection 2, paragraph "h" should be stricken. The  
28 department further requests that the grant funds not revert to  
29 the general fund to allow more flexibility in establishing  
30 grant application cycles, contract terms, and to ensure that  
31 moneys are expended in a prudent manner by grantees not facing  
32 reversion deadlines.
