EXEMPTING CERTAIN DECORATIVE FOUNTAINS FROM PERMITS AS SWIMMING POOLS AND SPAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 179.1, subsection 4, Code 1997, is amended to read as follows:

4. "Swimming pool" means an artificial basin and its appurtenances, either constructed or operated for swimming, wading, or diving, and includes a swimming pool, wading pool, water slide, or associated bathhouse. "Swimming pool" does not include a decorative fountain which does not serve primarily as a wading or swimming pool and the drain of which contains
