HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa to restrict the expenditure of license fees  
3 and excise taxes received from hunting, fishing, and trapping  
4 activities or equipment, and other public or private funds  
5 appropriated, allocated, or given for fish, game, and wildlife  
6 protection purposes.

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is  
4 amended by adding the following new section:

5 FISH AND GAME PROTECTION FUNDS. SEC. 9. The revenue from  
6 all license fees from hunting, fishing, and trapping  
7 activities and excise taxes from hunting, fishing, and  
8 trapping weapons, munitions, and equipment, and any public or  
9 private funds appropriated, allocated, or given for fish,  
10 game, or wildlife protection purposes, shall be used  
11 exclusively for activities related to the propagation,  
12 management, harvest, and protection of fish, game, and  
13 wildlife resources.

14 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the  
15 Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the General  
16 Assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members  
17 of the General Assembly and the Secretary of State is directed  
18 to cause it to be published for three consecutive months  
19 before the date of the election as provided by law.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This joint resolution proposes a constitutional amendment  
22 to provide that fees collected from hunting, fishing, and  
23 trapping activities and excise taxes collected from weapons,  
24 munitions, and equipment used for hunting, fishing, or  
25 trapping, and other public or private funds appropriated,  
26 allocated, or given for fish, game, or wildlife protection  
27 purposes, shall be used exclusively for activities related to  
28 the propagation, management, harvest, and protection of fish,  
29 game, and wildlife resources. The resolution, if adopted,  
30 would be referred to the next general assembly before being  
31 submitted to the electorate for ratification.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IOWA TO RESTRICT THE EXPENDITURE OF LICENSE FEES AND EXCISE TAXES RECEIVED FROM HUNTING, FISHING, AND TRAPPING ACTIVITIES OR EQUIPMENT, AND OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE FUNDS APPROPRIATED, ALLOCATED, OR GIVEN FOR FISH, GAME, AND WILDLIFE PROTECTION PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is proposed:

Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding the following new section:

FISH AND GAME PROTECTION FUNDS. SEC. 9. The revenue from all license fees from hunting, fishing, and trapping activities and excise taxes from hunting, fishing, and trapping weapons, munitions, and equipment, and any public or private funds appropriated, allocated, or given for fish, game, or wildlife protection purposes, shall be used exclusively for activities related to the propagation, management, harvest, and protection of fish, game, and wildlife resources.

Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members of the General Assembly and the Secretary of State is directed
