11 hundred ninety-two in the manner required by the Constitution

13 EXPLANATION

14 This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the Con-
15 stitution of the State of Iowa, for adoption by the second
16 consecutive general assembly, repealing the constitutional
17 provision which forever disqualifies participants of a duel
18 from holding office. The resolution, if adopted, would be
19 submitted to the electorate for ratification.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is proposed:

1. Section 5 of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is repealed.

The foregoing proposed amendment, having been adopted and agreed to by the Seventy-third General Assembly, 1989 Session, thereafter duly published, and now adopted and agreed to by the Seventy-fourth General Assembly in this joint resolution, shall be submitted to the people of the State of Iowa at the general election in November of the year nineteen
