11 EXPLANATION

12 The bill alters the prohibition against allowing persons
13 under the age of 21 years from being in the area of an
14 excursion boat where gambling is conducted. The bill permits
15 employees of the licensee who are 18 years of age or older to
16 be in gambling areas while acting in the course of their
17 employment. The bill does not alter the prohibition against
18 wagering by persons under the age of 21 on excursion gambling
19 boats.

21 who has not reached the age of eighteen twenty-one
22 years. This does not prohibit the lawful purchase of

25 twenty-one years. A licensee or a licensee's employee
26 who knowingly sells or offers to sell a lottery ticket
27 or share to a person who has not reached the age of
28 eighteen twenty-one years is guilty of a simple
29 misdemeanor. In addition the license of a licensee
30 shall be suspended. A prize won by a person who has
31 not reached the age of eighteen twenty-one years but
32 who purchases a winning ticket or share in violation
33 of this subsection shall be forfeited."

RELATING TO WAGERS BY CERTAIN PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF
EIGHTEEN YEARS ON EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS, AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 99F.9, subsection 6, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

6. A person under the age of ~~twenty-one~~ eighteen years shall not make a wager on an excursion gambling boat and shall not be allowed in the area of the excursion boat where gambling is being conducted.

Sec. 2. Section 99F.15, subsection 2, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

2. A person knowingly permitting a person under the age of ~~twenty-one~~ eighteen years to make a wager is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.
