30 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

31 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

32 The need for the bill: The provisions of the Iowa uniform
33 controlled substances Act contained in Iowa Code chapter 204
34 and the federal Uniform Controlled Substances Act need to be
35 as similar as possible in order to achieve effective

1 regulation and enforcement.

2 The purpose of the bill: To ensure uniformity between the
3 Iowa uniform controlled substances Act contained in Iowa Code
4 chapter 204 and the federal Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

5 The intent of the bill: To amend Iowa Code chapter 204 to
6 include recent amendments to the federal Uniform Controlled
7 Substances Act.

8 Problem the bill is intended to address: The bill is
9 intended to prevent problems which may occur when state and
10 federal law conflict and does not address any specific
11 problems.
