17 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

18 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

19 The federal share of the cost of the armories has been
20 appropriated by Congress but United States secretary of
21 defense Richard Cheney has imposed a construction moratorium
22 over all construction until a base closure commission
23 completes its study. This moratorium currently runs through
24 April 16, 1991, and affects both FY 90 and FY 91 federal
25 appropriations. It is possible that the moratorium could last
26 beyond April 16 but should end prior to March 30, 1992. The
27 armories are designed and contracts can be let as soon as the
28 moratorium is lifted.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REVERSION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION OF ARMORIES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC DEFENSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. 1989 Iowa Acts, chapter 307, section 16, unnumbered paragraph 4, is amended to read as follows:

The provisions of section 8.33 do not apply to the funds appropriated in this section. The unobligated and unencumbered funds remaining on March 30, ~~1991~~ 1992, from the funds appropriated in this section for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, shall revert to the general fund of the state on March 30, ~~1991~~ 1992.
