10 of the affected institutions. The final decision on the an
11 increase in tuition, fees, or charges for a fiscal year shall
12 be made no later than the regular meeting held in November of
13 the preceding fiscal year and shall be reflected in a final
14 docket memorandum that states the aggregate actual cost of
15 attending each of the institutions of higher education under
16 the board's control. The regular meeting held in November
17 shall be held in Ames, Cedar Falls, or Iowa City and shall not
18 be held during the period in which classes have been suspended
19 for Thanksgiving vacation.

EXPLANATION

21 This bill requires the state board of regents to make a
22 final decision on increases in tuition, fees, or charges for a
23 fiscal year by the November meeting of the previous fiscal
24 year. The regents are also to reflect the final decision as
25 to an increase or increases in a final docket memorandum
26 statement of aggregate actual cost of attending the regents'
27 institutions affected by the increase.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIME OF MAKING DECISIONS FOR AND NOTICE OF FINAL DECISIONS FOR INCREASES IN TUITION, FEES, OR CHARGES AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE STATE BOARD OF REGENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 262.9, subsection 18, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

18. Not less than thirty days prior to action by the board on any proposal to increase tuition, fees, or charges at one or more of the institutions of higher education under its control, send written notification of the amount of the proposed increase including a copy of the proposed tuition increase docket memorandum prepared for its consideration to the presiding officers of the student government organization of the affected institutions. The final decision on the an increase in tuition or mandatory fees charged to all students at an institution for a fiscal year shall be made no later than the regular meeting held in November of the preceding fiscal year and shall be reflected in a final docket memorandum that states the estimated total cost of attending each of the institutions of higher education under the board's control. The regular meeting held in November shall be held in Ames, Cedar Falls, or Iowa City and shall not be held
