A person who returns a container 11 bearing a registered mark of a company processing or 12 delivering milk that was taken without the consent of the 13 owner prior to July 1, 1991, may return the container without 14 penalty from April 30, 1992, through June 30, 1992.

16 This bill amends the definition of "container" for milk or 17 milk products to include cases and provides an amnesty period 18 for persons to return milk containers taken without the 19 owner's consent. The amnesty would prevent the application of 20 the simple misdemeanor penalty in section 189.21.
