1 Section 1. Section 317.25, Code 1991, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 317.25 TEASEL, MULTIFLORA ROSE, AND PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE
4 PROHIBITED -- EXCEPTIONS.

5 A person shall not sell, offer for sale, or distribute
6 teasel (*Dipsacus*) biennial, the multiflora rose (*rosa*
7 multiflora), purple loosestrife (*lythrum salicaria*), or seeds
8 of them in any form in this state. However, this section does
9 not prohibit the sale, offer for sale, or distribution of the
10 multiflora rose (*rosa multiflora*) used for understock for
11 either cultivated roses or ornamental shrubs in gardens. This
12 section also does not prohibit the sale, offer for sale, or
13 distribution of varieties of the purple loosestrife (*lythrum*
14 *virgatum*) when used for ornamental gardens, and which are
15 sterile or nonaggressive according to a list published by the
16 state weed commissioner pursuant to chapter 17A. Any person
17 violating the provisions of this section is subject to a fine
18 of not exceeding one hundred dollars.

19 EXPLANATION

20 Section 317.25 prohibits the sale, offer for sale, or
21 distribution of the plant referred to as purple loosestrife.
22 The bill provides that the section does not prohibit the sale,
23 offer for sale, or distribution of varieties which are non-
24 aggressive according to a list published by the state weed
25 commissioner.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE SALE, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTION OF
PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 317.25, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

317.25 TEASEL, MULTIFLORA ROSE, AND PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE PROHIBITED -- EXCEPTIONS.

A person shall not sell, offer for sale, or distribute teasel (*Dipsacus*) biennial, the multiflora rose (*rosa multiflora*), purple loosestrife (*lythrum salicaria*), or seeds of them in any form in this state. However, this section does not prohibit the sale, offer for sale, or distribution of the multiflora rose (*rosa multiflora*) used for understock for either cultivated roses or ornamental shrubs in gardens. This section also does not prohibit the sale, offer for sale, or distribution of varieties of the purple loosestrife (*lythrum virgatum*) when used for ornamental gardens, and which are sterile or nonaggressive according to a list published by the state weed commissioner pursuant to chapter 17A. A person engaged in the business of selling purple loosestrife shall keep accurate records, as specified by the department, of each variety of purple loosestrife sold, offered for sale, or distributed. The person shall allow the department of agriculture and land stewardship to inspect the records during regular business hours. Any person violating the provisions
