A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to increasing the fees for issuance or
2 replacement or renewal of a permit to carry weapons.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 535

1 Section 1. Section 724.11, Code 1991, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 724.11 ISSUANCE OF PERMIT TO CARRY WEAPONS.

4 Applications for permits to carry weapons shall be made to
5 the sheriff of the county in which the applicant resides.
6 Applications from persons who are nonresidents of the state,
7 or whose need to go armed arises out of employment by the
8 state, shall be made to the commissioner of public safety. In
9 either case, the issuance of the permit shall be by and at the
10 discretion of the sheriff or commissioner, who shall, before
11 issuing the permit, determine that the requirements of
12 sections 724.6 to 724.10 have been satisfied. However, the
13 training program requirements in section 724.9 may be waived
14 for renewal permits. The issuing officer shall collect a fee
15 of five ten dollars, except from a duly appointed peace
16 officer or correctional officer, for each permit issued.
17 Renewal permits or duplicate permits shall be issued for a fee
18 of two five dollars. The issuing officer shall notify the
19 commissioner of public safety of the issuance of any permit at
20 least monthly and forward to the director an amount equal to
21 two dollars for each permit issued and one dollar for each
22 renewal or duplicate permit issued. All such fees received by
23 the commissioner shall be paid to the treasurer of state and
24 deposited in the operating account of the department of public
25 safety to offset the cost of administering this chapter. Any
26 unspent balance as of June 30 of each year shall revert to the
27 general fund as provided by section 8.33.

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EXPLANATION

29 This bill increases the fee for issuance of a permit to
30 carry weapons to \$10 and increases the fee for replacement or
31 renewal of a permit to \$5.

FISCAL NOTE**

A fiscal note for Senate File 535 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 535 increases the fee for issuance of a permit to carry weapons from \$5 to \$10 and increases the fee for replacement or renewal of a permit from \$2 to \$5.

Assumptions

There will be 21,043 permits issued annually by local law enforcement and 82 by the Department of Public Safety. This information is based on actual data from 1989.

10% of the permits issued will be new permits and 90% will be renewal permits.
