1 Section 1. Section 261.1, subsection 3, Code 1991, is  
2 amended by striking the subsection.

3 Sec. 2. Section 261.1, subsection 6, unnumbered paragraph  
4 1, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

5 Seven Eight additional members to be appointed by the  
6 governor. One of such the members shall be selected to  
7 represent private colleges, private universities and private  
8 junior colleges located in the state of Iowa. When appointing  
9 such-one this member, the governor shall give careful  
10 consideration to any person or persons nominated or  
11 recommended by any organization or association of some or all  
12 private colleges, private universities and private junior  
13 colleges located in the state of Iowa. One of the members  
14 shall be selected to represent community colleges located in  
15 the state of Iowa. When appointing this member, the governor  
16 shall give careful consideration to any person or persons  
17 nominated or recommended by any organization or association of  
18 Iowa community colleges. One such member shall be enrolled as  
19 a student at a board of regents institution, community  
20 college, or accredited private institution. One such member  
21 shall be a representative of a lending institution located in  
22 this state. One such member shall be a representative of the  
23 Iowa student loan liquidity corporation. The other three such  
24 members, none of whom shall be official board members or  
25 trustees of an institution of higher learning or of an  
26 association of such institutions of higher learning, shall be  
27 selected to represent the general public.

28 EXPLANATION

29 This bill changes the membership of the college student aid  
30 commission by replacing the member of the state council on  
31 vocational education with a member who is to represent Iowa  
32 community colleges. The community college representative will  
33 be appointed by the governor, and is subject to confirmation  
34 by the senate under section 69.19. The governor, in making  
35 the appointment, is to give careful consideration to

1 recommendations or nominations made by Iowa community college  
2 organizations or associations.

When appointing this member, the governor shall give careful consideration to any person or persons nominated or recommended by any organization or association of Iowa community colleges. One such member shall be enrolled as a student at a board of regents institution, community college, or accredited private institution. One such member shall be a representative of a leading institution located in this state. One such member shall be a representative of the Iowa student loan liquidity corporation. The other three such members, none of whom shall be official board members or trustees of an institution of higher learning or of an
