1 Section 1. Section 321.189, subsection 7, Code 1993, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. CLASS M LICENSE EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS. A person under
4 ~~the age of eighteen~~ applying for a driver's license valid for
5 the operation of a motorcycle shall be required to
6 successfully complete a motorcycle education course either
7 approved and established by the department of education or
8 from a private or commercial driver education school licensed
9 by the department before the class M license will be issued.

10 A public school district shall charge a student a fee which
11 shall not exceed the actual cost of instruction minus moneys
12 received by the school district under subsection 9.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill requires that all persons applying for a class M
15 license shall be required to successfully complete an approved
16 motorcycle education course. Current law requires only those
17 persons under 18 years of age to complete the course.

The provisions of this Act which amend section 321.189, take effect May 1, 1995, or at such time as the department of education provides adequate training vehicles, instructors, curriculum materials, training sites, and program funding for training for all persons who are required to complete the motorcycle education course or for any person who would like to complete the motorcycle education course, whichever is earlier. The department of

education shall notify the state department of transportation when the department of education has the resources available to effectively offer the motorcycle education course.
