RELATING TO THE EXPANSION OF THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 303.4, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

303.4 STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF 10WA -- BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

- A state historical society board of trustees is established consisting of seven <u>twelve</u> members selected as follows:
- a. Three members shall be elected by the members of the state historical society according to rules established by the board of trustees.
- b. Pour-members-shall-be-appointed-by-the-governory-two-of whom-shall-be-on-the-faculty-of-a-college-or-university-in-the state-in-disciplines-related-to-the-activities-of-the historical-society The governor shall appoint one member from each of the state's congressional districts.
- c. The governor shall appoint four members from the state at large, at least one of whom shall be on the faculty of a college or university in the state engaged in a discipline related to the activities of the historical society.
- 2. The term of office of members of the board of trustees is three years commencing and ending as provided in section 69.19. The terms of office of the governor's appointees are staggered so-that-in-one-year-two-members-are-appointed-and-in each-of-the-next-two-years-one-member-is-appointed terms of three years each, so that three members are appointed each year.
 - Sec. 2. TRANSITION. To implement this Act:
- 1. The current members of the board shall remain on the existing appointment cycle so that in 1993 one current member

vacancy exists for a three-year term; two new members shall be appointed for one-year terms; one new member shall be appointed for a two-year term; and two new members shall be appointed for three-year terms.

- 2. In 1994, one current member vacancy exists for a threeyear term with two positions of the members initially appointed in 1993 to be vacant for appointment to three-year terms.
- 3. In 1995, two current member vacancies will be up for three-year terms with one position of a member initially appointed in 1993 to be vacant for appointment to a three-year term.
- 4. Beginning in 1996, there will be three vacancies each year.
