# HOUSE FILE 2099 REVISED FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for House File 2099 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 2099 provides for the issuance of special "Natural Resources" motor vehicle license plates. The bill establishes a natural resources fee of \$35 for the special plates which is credited to the Resource Enhancement and Protection (REAP) Fund and paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The bill also requires a fee of \$45, paid in addition to the \$35 natural resources fee, for personalized natural resources plates. The \$45 fee for personalized plates is credited to the Road Use Tax Fund (RUTF).

The annual natural resources renewal fee for the special plates is \$10, paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. This fee is credited to the REAP Fund. An annual fee of \$5 for a personalized plate is required in addition to the \$10 natural resources renewal fee. The annual \$5 renewal fee for personalized plates is credited to the RUTF.



### Assumptions:

SENATE CLIP SHEET

The number of plates issued will be 20,000, approximately half of the number of first-year sesquicentennial plates sales.

It will cost \$2.40 to manufacture each pair of plates.

#### Fiscal Effect:

The total revenue generated the first year is estimated at \$700,000. These funds will be deposited into the REAP Fund.

Total cost to the RUTF for license plate production is estimated at \$48,000.

The annual renewal income is estimated at \$200,000. These funds will be deposited into the REAP Fund.



# HOUSE FILE 2099 FISCAL NOTE



House File 2099 provides for the issuance of special "Natural Resources" motor vehicle license plates. The bill establishes a natural resources fee of \$35 for the special plates which is credited to the Resource Enhancement and Protection (REAP) Fund and paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The bill also requires a fee of \$45, paid in addition to the \$35 natural resources fee, for personalized natural resources plates. The \$45 fee for personalized plates is credited to the Road Use Tax Fund (RUTF).

The annual natural resources renewal fee for the special plates is \$10, paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. This fee is credited to the REAP Fund. An annual fee of \$5 for a personalized plate is required in addition to the \$10 natural resources renewal fee. The annual \$5 renewal fee for personalized plates is credited to the RUTF.

# Assumptions:

The number of plates issued will be 45,000, similar to the number of sesquicentennial plates issued. Of the total plates issued, 2,500 will be personalized. This is approximately half of the total number of personalized sesquicentennial plates issued.

It will cost \$2.40 to manufacture each pair of plates.

#### Fiscal Effect:

Total cost to the RUTF for license plate production is as follows: 45,000 plates @ \$2.40.....\$ 108,000

BS IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IONA:

Section 1. Section 321.34. Code Supplement 1993, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 17. NATURAL RESOURCES PLATES.

- a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the director may issue natural resources plates to the owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, light delivery truck, panel delivery truck, pickup, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, or travel trailer.
- b. Natural resources plates shall be designed by the department in cooperation with the department of natural resources which design shall include on the plate the name of the county where the vehicle is registered.
- c. The special natural resources fee for letter number designated natural resources plates is thirty-five dollars. The fee for personalized natural resources plates is forty-five dollars which shall be paid in addition to the special natural resources fee of thirty-five dollars. The fees collected by the director under this subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of state and credited to the road use tax fund. Notwithstanding section 423.24, and prior to the crediting of revenues to the road use tax fund under section 423.24, subsection 1, paragraph "d", the treasurer of state shall credit monthly from those revenues to the lowa resources enhancement and protection fund created pursuant to section 455A.18, the amount of the special natural resources fees collected in the previous month for the natural resources plates.
- d. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the applicant shall surrender the current registration receipt and

plates to the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate the special registration plates in the same manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section. The annual special natural resources fee for letter number designated plates is ten dollars which shall be paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The annual fee for personalized natural resources plates is five dollars which shall be paid in addition to the annual special natural resources fee and the regular annual registration fee. The annual special natural resources fee shall be credited as provided under paragraph "c".

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1995.
