1 Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 7, Code 1993, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 7. As used in this section a "farm unit" is all the
4 parcels of land, not necessarily contiguous, which are
5 operated as a unit for agricultural purposes and which are
6 under the lawful control of the landowner or tenant, and a
7 "tenant" is a person, other than the landowner ~~or-landowner's~~
8 family, who resides on the farm unit and is actively engaged
9 in the operation of the farm unit.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill amends the definition of tenant to include a
12 person who is a member of the landowner's family. The
13 amendment allows a member of the landowner's family who is a
14 tenant and residing on the farm unit to receive free deer and
15 wild turkey licenses for the farm unit.

AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF TENANT FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR FREE DEER AND WILD TURKEY HUNTING LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 7, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

7. As used in this section a "farm unit" is all the parcels of land, not necessarily contiguous, which are operated as a unit for agricultural purposes and which are under the lawful control of the landowner or tenant, and a "tenant" is a person, other than the landowner or landowner's
