1 Section 1. Section 455B.133, Code Supplement 1993, is
2 amended by adding the following new subsection:
3 NEW SUBSECTION. 9. Adopt rules allowing asphalt shingles
4 to be burned in a fire set for the purpose of bona fide
5 training of public or industrial employees in fire fighting
6 methods only if a notice is provided to the director
7 containing testing results indicating that the asphalt
8 shingles do not contain asbestos. Each fire department shall
9 be permitted to set two fires per year as allowed under this
10 subsection.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill requires the environmental protection commission
13 to adopt rules allowing for the burning of asphalt shingles
14 for training fire fighters in fire fighting methods as long as
15 the notice that is required to be provided to the director of
16 the department of natural resources contains testing results
17 indicating that the asphalt shingles do not contain asbestos.
18 It limits a fire department to two fires per year. Current
19 administrative rules, which are codified in 567 Iowa
20 administrative code 23.2(3)(g), require that a ten-day notice
21 be given to the director of the department of natural
22 resources and that all asphalt roofing and other asbestos-
23 containing materials must be removed prior to the training
24 fire.

RELATING TO THE ASBESTOS TESTING FOR TRAINING FIRES INVOLVING ASPHALT SHINGLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 455B.133, Code Supplement 1993, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 9. Adopt rules allowing asphalt shingles to be burned in a fire set for the purpose of bona fide training of public or industrial employees in fire fighting methods only if a notice is provided to the director containing testing results indicating that the asphalt shingles do not contain asbestos. Each fire department shall
