1 Section 1. Section 192A.11, Code 1993, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A processor or distributor may lend
4 equipment to a retailer, for not longer than two consecutive
5 weeks each month, if the equipment is used for the display and
6 sale of the processor's or distributor's products. The
7 equipment must be mounted on wheels, it must be designed for
8 consumer access on all sides, and it must have a capacity of
9 less than fifteen cubic feet.

10 EXPLANATION

11 Current law in Code section 192A.11 prohibits a processor
12 or distributor of dairy products from furnishing, selling,
13 giving, lending, or renting any equipment to a retailer of
14 dairy products. The section also includes several exceptions
15 to the prohibition. This bill adds another exception, by
16 providing that a processor or distributor may lend equipment
17 to a retailer for up to two consecutive weeks during each
18 month, for the display and sale of the processor's or
19 distributor's products. The equipment must be mounted on
20 wheels, it must be designed for consumer access on all sides,
21 and it must have a capacity of less than 15 cubic feet.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE DISPLAY AND SALE OF DAIRY PRODUCTS BY ALLOWING PROCESSORS AND DISTRIBUTORS TO LEND EQUIPMENT TO RETAILERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 192A.11, Code 1993, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. A processor or distributor may lend equipment to a retailer, for not longer than two consecutive weeks each month, if the equipment is used for the display and sale of the processor's or distributor's products. The equipment must be mounted on wheels, it must be designed for
