Section 1. Section 490.1422, Code Supplement 1993, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. Notwithstanding the reinstatement period established in subsection 1, a corporation administratively dissolved after December 31, 1984, which files an application for reinstatement prior to January 1, 1996, containing the information required under subsection 1, shall be treated as if its application had been timely filed under subsection 1. In this case, the secretary of state shall process the application pursuant to subsection 2 and, if a certificate of reinstatement is issued, the provisions of subsection 3 shall apply.
