RELATING TO STATE WORK SEARCH REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR EXTENDED UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA

Section 1. Section 96.29, subsection 2, Code 1991, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. c. This subsection shall not apply to claims for extended benefits for weeks of unemployment beginning March 6, 1993, and ending before January 1, 1995, or if otherwise prohibited by federal law.
