26 and mandatory mediation proceedings. In general, a creditor,
27 must receive a release by the farm mediation service prior to
28 initiating a civil proceeding to resolve the dispute. The
29 department of natural resources must obtain a release prior to
30 inventorying land for wetland designation. A dispute
31 involving a nuisance or the performance of a contract for the
32 care and feeding of livestock may be resolved by mediation.
33 The current provisions establishing farm mediation are
34 repealed on July 1, 1993. This bill provides that the
35 provisions are effective until July 1, 1994. The bill becomes
