3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 556.37 UNCLAIMED PERSONAL
2 PROPERTY HELD BY A DRY CLEANING ESTABLISHMENT.

3 All property deposited with a dry cleaning establishment
4 which remains unclaimed for a period of three months after the
5 establishment has attempted to contact the owner of the
6 property by ordinary mail one time at the property owner's
7 last known mailing address, may be presumed abandoned and
8 disposed of in any manner as determined by the establishment.

9 EXPLANATION

10 This bill provides that property which remains unclaimed at
11 a dry cleaning establishment for three months after the
12 establishment has attempted to contact the owner of the
13 property by ordinary mail, can be disposed of in any manner as
14 determined by the establishment.



RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY LEFT UNCLAIMED AT A DRY CLEANING ESTABLISHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 556F.1 UNCLAIMED PERSONAL PROPERTY HELD BY A DRY CLEANING ESTABLISHMENT.

All property deposited with a dry cleaning establishment which remains unclaimed for a period of four months after the establishment has attempted to contact the owner of the property by ordinary mail one time at the property owner's last known mailing address, may be presumed abandoned and
