**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act extending the waiver provision for the education standards  
2 requiring an articulated sequential elementary-secondary  
3 guidance program and a media services program to support the  
4 total curriculum.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.11A, subsection 3, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 1, and subsection 4, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code  
3 1993, are amended to read as follows:

4 Schools and school districts unable to meet the standard

4 EXPLANATION

5 This bill extends a provision that permits nonpublic  
6 schools and school districts to apply to the department of  
7 education for a one-year waiver from education standards  
8 requiring an articulated sequential elementary-secondary  
9 guidance program and a media services program to support the  
10 total curriculum. The school or district may apply for the  
11 waiver for the school year beginning July 1, 1993, and may  
12 apply for an extension of the waiver for the school year  
13 beginning July 1, 1994.

EXTENDING THE WAIVER PROVISION FOR THE EDUCATION STANDARDS  
REQUIRING AN ARTICULATED SEQUENTIAL ELEMENTARY-SECONDARY  
GUIDANCE PROGRAM AND A MEDIA SERVICES PROGRAM TO SUPPORT  
THE TOTAL CURRICULUM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 256.11A, subsection 3, unnumbered  
paragraph 1, and subsection 4, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code  
1993, are amended to read as follows:

Schools and school districts unable to meet the standard  
adopted by the state board under section 256.17, Code  
Supplement 1987, and contained in section 256.17, subsection  
9A, effective July 17, 1989, requiring that on July 17, 1989,  
each board of school district operating a kindergarten  
through grade twelve program to provide an articulated  
sequential elementary-secondary guidance program may, not  
later than January 17, 1989 August 1, 1993, for the school year  
beginning July 1, 1989 1993, file a written request to the  
department of education that the department waive the  
requirement for that school or school district. The  
procedures specified in subsection 5 apply to the request.  
Not later than August 1, 1992 1994, for the school year  
beginning July 1, 1992 1994, the board of directors of a  
school district or the authorities in charge of a nonpublic  
school may request a one-year extension of the waiver.

~~Schools and school districts are not required to meet the  
standard adopted by the state board of education under section  
256.17, Code Supplement 1987, and contained in section 256.17,  
subsection 9, paragraph "b", effective July 17, 1990, that  
requires the board to establish and operate a media services  
program to support the total curriculum until July 17, 1990,  
except as otherwise provided in this subsection. Not later~~

than August 1, 1992 1993, for the school year beginning July  
1, 1992 1993, the board of directors of a school district, or  
authorities in charge of a nonpublic school, may file a  
written request with the department of education that the  
department waive the requirement to establish and operate a  
media services program to support the total curriculum for  
that district or school. The procedures specified in  
subsection 5 apply to the request. Not later than August 1,  
1994, for the school year beginning July 1, 1994, the board of  
directors of a school district or the authorities in charge of  
a nonpublic school may request an additional one-year  
extension of the waiver.
