A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the maximum age for participants in an
2 organized amateur boxing contest and providing an effective
3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 501

1 Section 1. Section 90A.10, subsection 1, Code 1993, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. A person age ~~thirty-eight~~ thirty-three years or older
4 shall not participate as a contestant in an organized amateur
5 boxing contest unless each contestant participating in the
6 contest is age ~~thirty-eight~~ thirty-three years or older. A
7 birth certificate, or other similar document, must be
8 submitted at the time of the prefight physical examination in
9 order to determine eligibility.

10 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
11 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill decreases the maximum age for participants in an
14 organized amateur boxing contest from 37 to 32. The bill also
15 eliminates the maximum age requirements if every participant
16 is aged 33 or older. Currently, the maximum age requirements
17 are eliminated if every participant is aged 38 or older. The
18 bill provides that it will take effect upon enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MAXIMUM AGE FOR PARTICIPANTS IN AN ORGANIZED AMATEUR BOXING CONTEST AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 90A.10, subsection 1, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

1. A person age ~~thirty-eight~~ thirty-three years or older shall not participate as a contestant in an organized amateur boxing contest unless each contestant participating in the contest is age ~~thirty-eight~~ thirty-three years or older. A birth certificate, or other similar document, must be submitted at the time of the preflight physical examination in order to determine eligibility.
