RELATING TO CERTAIN TRANSACTIONS WITH A RETAILER INVOLVING A SATELLITE TERMINAL AND PROVIDING AN EPFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 527.5, subsection 13, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

13. Effective July 1, ±993 1994, any transaction engaged in with a retailer through a satellite terminal located in this state by means of an access device which results in a debit to a customer asset account shall be cleared and paid at par to the retailer during the settlement of such transaction to the retailer. Processing fees and charges for such transactions to the retailer shall not be based on a percentage of the amount of the transaction. All accounting documents reflecting such fees and charges shall separately identify transactions which have resulted in a debit to a customer asset account and the charges imposed. The provisions of this subsection shall apply to all satellite terminals, including limited-function terminals and multiple use terminals.
