A BILL FOR

_____An Act relating to procedures for the issuance and use of general obligation bonds by counties for the funding of water systems and facilities. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. Section 331.441, subsection 2, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (12), subparagraph subdivisions (a) through (c), 3 Code 1993, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) The county board of supervisors may on its own motion 5 or upon written petition of a water supplier, established 6 under chapter 357A or 504A, designate the territory to be 7 served as a special taxing district. The taxing district 8 shall be composed of election precincts. The county's debt 9 service tax levy for county general obligation bonds issued 10 for the purposes set out in this subparagraph shall be levied 11 only against real property within the county which is included 12 within the boundaries of the special taxing district. A 13 property not presently included within the boundaries of the 14 special taxing district may petition to be included in the 15 district subsequent to its establishment.
- (b) General obligation bonds for the purposes outlined in this subparagraph are subject to an election held pursuant to section 331.442, subsections 1 through 4, or are subject to the right of petition for an election as provided in section 331.442, subsection 5, paragraphs "a", "b", and "c", without limitation on the amount of the bond issue or the size of the county, and the board shall include notice of the right of petition in the notice required. However, under either election procedure, only the voters within the taxing district shall vote or sign a petition.
- 26 (c) A county and a city entering into a water supplier
 27 agreement shall provide in the agreement for a different rate
 28 of the county's debt service tax levy against benefited-and
 29 nonbenefited property based upon inclusion or exclusion within
 30 the taxing district or based upon the services to be provided.

31 EXPLANATION

This bill amends provisions relating to the use of general obligation bonds issued by counties and payable from a levy of ad valorem taxes on taxable property within the county for funding the acquisition, construction, reconstruction,

l improvement, repair, or equipping of water systems and 2 facilities. The bill requires that the taxing district be 3 composed of election precincts. The bill provides for 4 election procedures. It provides that only voters within the 5 taxing district can vote in a bond election or sign a petition 6 to hold such an election. It also provides that a water 7 supplier agreement must provide a rate of the county's debt 8 service tax levy against property based upon inclusion or 9 exclusion within the taxing district or based upon the 10 services provided. 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 331.441, subsection 2, paragraph b, subparagraph (12), subparagraph subdivisions (a) through (c), Code Supplement 1993, are amended by striking the subparagraph subdivisions, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- (a) The county board of supervisors may on its own motion or upon a written petition of a water supplier established under chapter 357A or 504A, direct the county auditor to establish a special service area tax district for the purpose of issuing general obligation bonds. The special service area tax district shall include only unincorporated portions of the county and shall be drawn according to engineering recommendations provided by the water supplier or the county engineer and, in addition, shall be drawn in order that an election provided for in subparagraph subdivision (b) can be administered. The county's debt service tax levy for the county general obligation bonds issued for the purposes set out in this subparagraph shall be levied only against taxable property within the county which is included within the boundaries of the special service area tax district. An owner of property not included within the boundaries of the special service area taxes district may petition the board of supervisors to be included in the special area tax district subsequent to its establishment.
- (b) General obligation bonds for the purposes described in this subparagraph are subject to an election held in the manner provided in section 331.442, subsections 1 through 4, if not later than fifteen days following the action by the county board of supervisors, eligible voters file a petition

with the county commissioner of elections asking that the question of issuing the bonds be submitted to the qualified electors of the special service area tax district. The petition must be signed by at least five percent of the registered voters residing in the special service area tax district. If the petition is duly filed within the fifteen days, the board of supervisors shall either adopt a resolution declaring that the proposal to issue the bonds is abandoned, or direct the county commissioner of elections to call a special election within a special service area tax district upon the question of issuing the bonds.
