1 Section 1. Section 192.110, Code 1993, is amended to read
2 as follows:

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill amends section 192.110 providing for ratings re-
27 quired for a permit issued by the department of agriculture
28 and land stewardship for the production of milk and milk
29 products.

30 The bill provides that in order to receive or retain a
31 permit, a producer must maintain facilities and equipment
32 which comply with requirements of the "Grade 'A' Pasteurized
33 Milk Ordinance, 1989 Revision," as provided in section

Section 1. Section 192.110, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:
