HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa to restrict the expenditure of state license  
3 fees received from hunting, fishing, and trapping, and other  
4 public or private funds appropriated, allocated, or received  
5 by the state for fish and wildlife protection purposes.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HJR 28

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
2 the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is  
4 amended by adding the following new section:

5 FISH AND WILDLIFE PROTECTION FUNDS. Sec. 9. All revenue  
6 derived from state license fees for hunting, fishing, and  
7 trapping, and all state funds appropriated for, and federal or  
8 private funds received by the state for, the regulation or  
9 advancement of hunting, fishing, or trapping, or the  
10 protection, propagation, restoration, management, or harvest of  
11 fish or wildlife, shall be used exclusively for the performance  
12 and administration of activities related to those purposes.

13 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the  
14 Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the General  
15 Assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members  
16 of the General Assembly and the Secretary of State is directed  
17 to cause it to be published for three consecutive months before  
18 the date of the election as provided by law.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This joint resolution proposes a constitutional amendment to  
21 provide that fees collected from hunting, fishing, and trapping  
22 and other public or private funds appropriated, allocated, or  
23 received by the state for the regulation or advancement of  
24 hunting, fishing, or trapping, or the protection, propagation,  
25 restoration, management, or harvest of fish or wildlife, shall  
26 be used exclusively for those purposes. The resolution, if  
27 adopted, would be referred to the next general assembly before  
28 being submitted to the electorate for ratification.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IOWA TO RESTRICT THE EXPENDITURE OF STATE LICENSE FEES RECEIVED FROM HUNTING, FISHING, AND TRAPPING, AND OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE FUNDS APPROPRIATED, ALLOCATED, OR RECEIVED BY THE STATE FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE PROTECTION PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is proposed:

Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding the following new section:

FISH AND WILDLIFE PROTECTION FUNDS. Sec. 9. All revenue derived from state license fees for hunting, fishing, and trapping, and all state funds appropriated for, and federal or private funds received by the state for, the regulation or advancement of hunting, fishing, or trapping, or the protection, propagation, restoration, management, or harvest of fish or wildlife, shall be used exclusively for the performance and administration of activities related to those purposes.

Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members
