BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. 1992 Iowa Acts, chapter 1231, section 68, is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 68. JUVENILE JUSTICE STUDY. The legislative council is requested to negotiate a contract with the Annie E. Casey Foundation to conduct a comprehensive study concerning the delivery of services to juveniles involved in delinquency proceedings. The study shall examine the types of placements for juveniles adjudicated delinquent, taking into consideration the effectiveness of the placements in meeting the needs of juveniles and the cost-effectiveness of the programs. ~~The study shall be completed and a report containing recommendations shall be submitted to the general assembly no later than March 17, 1993~~ A preliminary report on the progress of the study, which contains preliminary findings, shall be submitted to the juvenile justice system study committee no later than March 30, 1993, and the final report containing findings and recommendations shall be submitted to the legislative council no later than June 30, 1993.
