The board of directors of a receiving district 7 8 under the open enrollment provisions of section 282.18 9 which determines that the funding received from the 10 district of residence for a pupil attending school in Il the receiving district is insufficient to provide the 12 educational program may certify by April 15 of the 13 base year the imposition of a supplemental open 14 enrollment levy on all taxable property in the school 15 district.
