15 This bill eliminates temporary licensure of nursing
16 examinees prior to taking the exam and allows the board of

20 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

21 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

22 The bill eliminates temporary licensure for examinees and
23 changes the length of temporary licensure for endorsees to
24 reflect the changes resulting from computerization of the
25 licensure examination and licensure printing. Year round
26 testing and issuance of licenses, in conjunction with the
27 elimination of temporary licensure for examinees, will ensure
28 nursing practice by qualified individuals in a timely manner.
29 The requirement for registered nurse supervision was
30 applicable only to examination candidates who were issued a
31 temporary license but did not hold a license from another
32 jurisdiction. Board determination of the effective period for
33 temporary licensure of endorsees from other jurisdictions
34 facilitates provision of nursing care by qualified individuals
35 with permanent licensure in the shortest time period.

RELATING TO TEMPORARY LICENSURE OF NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 152.9, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

152.9 TEMPORARY LICENSE.

The board may issue a temporary license to a natural person who has completed the requirements of and applied for licensure, either by examination or endorsement. ~~A temporary license shall not remain effective longer than the time between application and the next issuance of licenses. A temporary license issued to a person not holding a foreign license to practice nursing shall be valid only when the temporary license is under the supervision of a registered~~
