It is also the intent of the general assembly that a performance-based pay plan and supplemental pay plan submitted by a district include a parent involvement policy designed to increase student achievement and selfesteem by bringing home and school into closer relationship and that provides methods by which parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the education of children. It is further the intent of the general assembly that real and fundamental change in the educational system must emerge from the school site if the education system is to remain relevant and that plans funded in this program must be an integral part of a comprehensive school district or area education agency

or more appropriately meet the educational needs of the area education agency.
