A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the payment of benefits pursuant to the state  
2 employees disability insurance program, and providing  
3 effective and retroactive applicability dates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 70A.20, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code  
2 1993, is amended to read as follows:

3 A state employees disability insurance program is created,  
4 which shall be administered by the director of the department  
5 of personnel and which shall provide disability benefits in an  
6 amount and for the employees as provided in this section. The  
7 monthly disability benefits shall provide twenty percent of  
8 monthly earnings if employed less than one year, forty percent  
9 of monthly earnings if employed one year or more but less than  
10 two years, and sixty percent of monthly earnings thereafter,  
11 reduced by primary and family social security determined at  
12 the time social security disability payments commence,  
13 workers' compensation if applicable, and any other state  
14 sponsored sickness or disability benefits payable. However,  
15 the amount of benefits payable under the Iowa public  
16 employees' retirement system pursuant to chapter 97B shall not  
17 reduce the benefits payable pursuant to this section.

18 Subsequent social security increases shall not be used to  
19 further reduce the insurance benefits payable. State  
20 employees shall receive credit for the time they were  
21 continuously employed prior to and on July 1, 1974. The  
22 following provisions apply to the employees disability  
23 insurance program:

24 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY DATES.  
25 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect  
26 upon enactment and applies retroactively to July 1, 1990.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill provides that benefits payable pursuant to the  
29 Iowa public employees' retirement system (IPERS) shall not  
30 reduce benefits payable under the state employees disability  
31 insurance program. The bill is immediately effective upon  
32 enactment and retroactive to July 1, 1990.

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SENATE FILE 56  
FISCAL NOTE

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A fiscal note for Senate File 56 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

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Senate File 56 provides that benefits payable pursuant to the Iowa Public Employees' Retirement System (IPERS) shall not reduce benefits payable under the State employee long-term disability insurance program. The bill is effective upon enactment and is retroactive to July 1, 1990.

Fiscal Effect:

The fiscal effect of SF 56 is minimal due to the fact that IPERS benefits have not been used in the past as an offset. Therefore, removing IPERS benefits as an offset would not result in an increase in the long-term disability insurance rates.
