3	A Concurrent Resolution urging the government of Franc
4	to discontinue nuclear weapons testing.
5	WHEREAS, since 1992, the United States and Britain
6	have observed a ban on nuclear weapons testing; and
7	WHEREAS, the President of the United States is on
8	record supporting an international treaty banning
9	nuclear weapons testing; and
10	WHEREAS, the Russian Federation has not tested a
11	nuclear weapon since 1990; and
12	WHEREAS, the independent governments of Ukraine,
13	Belarus, and Kazakhstan, with monetary American aid,
14	are actively seeking to demobilize their nuclear
15	weapons left over from the Soviet era; and
16	WHEREAS, the French testing of nuclear weapons has
17	resulted in significant international opposition; and
18	WHEREAS, public opinion polling shows that 60
19	percent of the French people oppose nuclear weapons
20	testing; and
21	WHEREAS, the French are risking long-term
22	environmental damage in the South Pacific through
23	nuclear weapons testing; and
24	WHEREAS, New Zealand claims that future nuclear
25	weapons testing could cause a substantial escape of
26	radioactive materials due to damaged geological
27	formations under the Mururoa Atoll caused by previous
28	nuclear weapons testing; and
29	WHEREAS, France, by continuing its nuclear weapons
30	testing, is endangering global efforts to curb nuclear

1 proliferation; NOW THEREFORE,
      BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
 3 SENATE CONCURRING, That the President of the United
 4 States is urged to continue expressing this country's
 5 displeasure with France for its nuclear weapons
 6 testing; and
      BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the citizens of Iowa
 8 are encouraged to protest continued nuclear weapons
 9 testing by France by joining the international boycott
10 of French products, particularly wine and cheese; and
      BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the
11
12 House of Representatives send a copy of this
13 resolution to the French Ambassador to the United
14 States and to the President of France, Jacques Chirac.
