1 A Concurrent Resolution posthumously honoring Mr. Loren  
2 Callendar, and recognizing his many contributions to  
3 city government and to the citizens of Siouxland.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Callendar vigorously served the labor  
5 community in Woodbury County serving a term as  
6 president of the Amalgamated Meatcutters and Butchers  
7 Workmen of North America, now the United Food and  
8 Commercial Workers International Union, and a term as  
9 chair of the Northwest Iowa Labor Council; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Loren Callendar's abilities as a  
11 consensus builder made him a valued member on the many  
12 boards and commissions on which he served; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Loren Callendar, during his  
14 distinguished lifetime, improved the quality of life  
15 in Sioux City by serving selflessly as a city council  
16 member for two decades, mayor pro tem five times, and  
17 as mayor of Sioux City from 1986 to 1989; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Callendar began his political career  
19 in 1975 in a tight race and served on the council  
20 continuously since that first election; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Callendar was the voice of the senior  
22 citizen and blue-collar worker, representing the  
23 common man in city government; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Callendar's conservative tax and  
25 spending messages were well received by the voters;

7 constitutes a loss for Sioux City; NOW THEREFORE,
