5 A Concurrent Resolution calling upon Iowa's congressional

13 WHEREAS, the growth and accumulation of the
14 national debt has resulted in problems for the
15 nation's economy and for state and local government
16 budgets; NOW THEREFORE,
17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
18 SENATE CONCURRING, That the General Assembly of the
19 State of Iowa requests the members of Iowa's
20 congressional delegation along with the members of the
21 l04th Congress of the United States to vote for the proposed Balanced Budget Amendment to the United States Constitution requiring a majority vote; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the 104th Congress include in the proposed Balanced Budget
26 Amendment, a provision excluding the payment of Social
27 Security benefits from the balanced budget requirement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the l04th Congress include in the proposed Balanced Budget

I Amendment, a provision prohibiting the federal
2 government from passing along unfunded mandates to the 3 state and local governments; and
4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the
5 104th Congress execute a plan that gradually balances
6 the federal budget by the year 2002; and
7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this
8 Resolution be transmitted to the Speaker of the United
9 States House of Representatives, the President of the
10 United States Senate, and all of the members of Iowa's
11 congressional delegation.
