3 A Concurrent Resolution calling upon Iowa's congressional
4 delegation to support a proposed amendment to the

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE 16 SENATE CONCURRING, That the General Assembly of the 17 State of Iowa requests the members of Iowa's 18 congressional delegation along with the members of the 19 104th Congress of the United States to vote for the 20 proposed consensus version of the Balanced Budget 21 Amendment to the United States Constitution, scheduled 22 to be voted on January 19, 1995, in the House of 23 Representatives; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of the 25 104th Congress execute a plan that gradually balances 26 the federal budget by the year 2002; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this
Resolution be transmitted to the Speaker of the United
States House of Representatives, the President of the
United States Senate, and all of the members of Iowa's
