A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to refreshments in rest areas during holiday
2 periods.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 115

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 314.27 REFRESHMENTS AT REST
2 AREAS ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS.

3 1. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise
4 requires:

5 a. "Free refreshments" means water, coffee, cookies, any
6 nonintoxicating beverage which is not already bottled or
7 canned, or baked dessert goods prepared by a nonprofit
8 organization or group, provided that the refreshments are
9 furnished to motorists by a nonprofit organization or group
10 without charge.

11 b. "Holiday periods" means the Memorial Day and Labor Day
12 weekends, commencing at six p.m. on the preceding Friday and
13 ending at six p.m. on Monday of the holiday weekend, and the
14 period surrounding Independence Day, commencing at six p.m. on
15 July 2 and ending at six p.m. on July 5.

16 2. Nonprofit organizations and groups shall be allowed to
17 provide free refreshments to motorists during holiday periods
18 at rest areas, as defined in section 306C.10, subject to
19 approval by the department.

20 3. The department shall adopt rules governing the
21 provision of refreshments at rest areas in accordance with
22 this section.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill provides that nonprofit organizations and groups
25 can serve free refreshments to motorists at rest areas
26 pursuant to rules that the department of transportation
27 adopts. The bill defines free refreshments as being limited
28 to providing motorists water, coffee, any nonintoxicating
29 beverage not already in a can or bottle, cookies, and baked
30 goods prepared by the organization. The bill further provides
31 that the holiday periods are limited to the Memorial Day and
32 Labor Day weekends as well as the Fourth of July period.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 314.27 REFRESHMENTS AT REST
AREAS ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS.

1. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise
requires:

a. "Free refreshments" means water, coffee, cookies, any
nonintoxicating, noncarbonated beverage which is not already
bottled or canned, doughnuts, or baked dessert goods dispensed
by a nonprofit organization, provided that the refreshments
are furnished to motorists by a nonprofit organization without
charge.

b. "Holiday periods" means the Memorial Day and Labor Day
weekends, commencing at noon on the preceding Friday and
ending at midnight between the Monday and Tuesday of the
holiday weekend, and the period surrounding Independence Day,
commencing at noon on July 1 and ending at midnight between
July 6 and July 7.

2. Nonprofit organizations shall be allowed to provide

holiday periods at rest areas, as defined in section 306C.10,
subject to approval by the department. The department shall
approve or disapprove applications by nonprofit organizations,

Sec. 2. The Iowa department of economic development, in
consultation with the state department of transportation and
the department for the blind, shall develop a program at rest
areas, as defined in section 306C.10, for the promotion of
agricultural products produced in Iowa. Any program to
promote agricultural products produced in Iowa shall not be
conducted during holiday periods as defined in section 314.27.
