3 A highway safety patrol fund is created as a separate fund
4 in the state treasury. Interest and other moneys earned by
5 the fund shall be deposited in the fund. The fund shall
6 include moneys credited from the use tax as allocated under
7 section 423.24, subsection 2. The moneys credited to the fund
8 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June
9 30, 1996, shall be appropriated as follows:

11 hundred sixty-seven dollars shall be appropriated to the
12 division of highway safety, uniformed force, and radio
13 communications of the department of public safety to be used
14 for salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous
15 purposes, including the state's contribution to the peace
16 officers' retirement, accident, and disability system provided
17 in chapter 97A in the amount of eighteen percent of the
18 salaries for which the funds are appropriated.

21 development and improvement of the commercial and industrial
22 highway network under section 313.2A.

23 It is the intent of the general assembly that moneys be
24 appropriated from the general fund of the state to partially

EXPLANATION

9 This bill allocates 20 percent of use tax revenues to a
10 highway safety patrol fund rather than the GAAP deficit
11 reduction account. It creates a highway safety patrol fund
12 and allocates \$32,960,467 of the moneys deposited in the fund
13 to the division of highway safety, uniformed force, and radio
14 communications of the department of public safety for the
15 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996.
16 The remaining moneys are appropriated to the primary road fund
17 to be used for the development and improvement of the state's
18 commercial and industrial highway network. The bill provides
19 language indicating that the intent of the general assembly is
20 to partially fund the highway patrol from the general fund of
21 the state in fiscal year 1997 and to fully fund the highway
22 patrol from the general fund of the state by fiscal year 2001
23 and each fiscal year thereafter. It states that it is further
24 intended by the general assembly that the highway safety
25 patrol fund be repealed and the use tax receipts be deposited
26 in the road use tax fund.
