1 Section 1. Section 811.1, subsection 2, Code 1995, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. A defendant appealing a conviction of a class "A"  
4 felony, murder, felonious assault, felonious child  
5 endangerment, sexual abuse in the second degree, sexual abuse  
6 in the third degree, kidnapping, robbery in the first degree,  
7 arson in the first degree, or burglary in the first degree, or  
8 any felony included in section 124.401, subsection 1,  
9 paragraph "a".

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill includes felonious child endangerment in the  
12 listing of nonbailable offenses at the time the defendant is  
13 appealing a conviction of the offense.
