12 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

13 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

14 The Iowa national guard currently has federal funds  
15 available to place dental practitioners in a national guard  
16 training status to perform dental work under the auspices of a  
17 national guardcare program for medically and dentally  
18 underserved communities. Legislation is required to allow the  
19 Iowa board of dental examiners to amend the administrative  
20 code of Iowa to allow dentists and dental hygienists to  
21 administer dental services in Iowa without first being  
22 licensed by the state of Iowa.

Section 1. Section 153.14, Code 1995, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. Dentists and dental hygienists who are licensed in another state and who are active or reserve members of the United States military service when acting in the line of duty in this state.
