RELATING TO THE FEE WHICH MAY BE CHARGED BY AN IOWA
COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK RECEIVING SITE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 8D.13, subsection 12, Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

12. The commission, on its own or as recommended by an advisory committee of the commission and approved by the commission, shall permit a fee to be charged by a receiving site to the originating-site originator of the communication provided on the network. The fee charged shall be for the purpose of recovering the operating costs of a receiving site. The fee charged shall be reduced by an amount received by the receiving site pursuant to a state appropriation for such costs, or federal assistance received for such costs. Fees established under this subsection shall be paid by the originating site directly to the receiving site. For purposes of this section, "operating costs" include the costs associated with the management or coordination, operations,
