3 receiving an informal adjustment for alcohol or drug

1 Section 1. Section 232.28, Code Supplement 1995, is
2 amended by adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 11. The intake officer shall notify the
4 superintendent of the school district or the superintendent's
5 designee, or the authorities in charge of a nonpublic school
6 which the child attends, of the filing of a complaint under
7 this section for an act which would be a violation of chapter
8 123, 124, or 321J, if committed by an adult, and of the filing
9 of a petition or dismissal of the complaint under this
10 section.

11 Sec. 2. Section 232.29, Code Supplement 1995, is amended
12 by adding the following new subsection:

13 NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. The person performing the duties of
14 intake officer shall notify the superintendent of the school
15 district or the superintendent's designee, or the authorities
16 in charge of the nonpublic school which the child attends, of
17 an informal adjustment regarding the child for an act which
18 would be a violation of chapter 123, 124, or 321J if committed
19 by an adult.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that a juvenile intake officer must
22 notify school district officials or the authorities in charge
23 of a nonpublic school when a delinquency complaint is filed or
24 a juvenile receives an informal adjustment for a delinquent
25 act which would be a violation of chapter 123 (alcoholic
26 beverages), 124 (controlled substances), or 321J (operating
27 while intoxicated) if committed by an adult.
