A BILL FOR

1 An Act excluding certain waste tires from disposal, collection,  
2 processing, and transportation requirements.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 455D.11, subsection 1, paragraph f,  
2 Code 1995, is amended to read as follows:

3 f. (1) "Waste tire" means a tire that is no longer  
4 suitable for its originally intended purpose due to wear,  
5 damage, or defect.

6 (2) "Waste tire" does not include a any of the following:

7 (a) A pneumatic tire.

8 (b) A processed tire which is used in part or in whole for  
9 the construction of erosion control structures, French drains,  
10 leachate beds, septic system drain fields, road base,  
11 culverts, field crossings, intakes, or other uses where the  
12 intended purpose is to produce a beneficial product.

13 (3) For the purposes of this section and sections 455D.11A  
14 and 455D.11B, a pneumatic tire and a processed tire are not  
15 solid waste as defined in section 455B.301.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill excludes from the definition of "waste tire"  
18 processed tires which are used in part or in whole for  
19 construction of erosion control structures and for other  
20 purposes specified in the bill for the purposes of the waste  
21 tire abatement program under the department of natural  
22 resources. The bill also specifies that these products do not  
23 constitute solid waste. The effect of these exclusions is to  
24 make inapplicable the prohibition against land disposal of  
25 these products and other limitations on transporting and  
26 disposal of these products which would otherwise apply to a  
27 waste tire.
