AN ACT

RELATING TO AN APPROPRIATION TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT FOR LONG-RANGE AND STRATEGIC PLANNING AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the judicial department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1996, the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

For the development and implementation of a long-range and strategic plan for the judicial branch of government through the supreme court's commission on planning for the 21st century:

..... \$ 50,000

Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this section which remain unexpended or unobligated at the close of the fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund of the state but shall remain available for expenditure for the designated purpose in the succeeding fiscal year.
