A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the definition of targeted small business for
2 the purpose of eligibility for the targeted small business
3 financial assistance program.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15.247, subsection 1, Code 1995, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: As used in this section, "small business" and-"targeted 4 small-business"-mean means the same as defined in section 5 15.102, subsections subsection 4, and 5 notwithstanding the 6 definition contained in section 15.102, subsection 5, 7 paragraph "a", unnumbered paragraph 1, "targeted small 8 business" means only a small business which is fifty-one 9 percent or more minority or female owned, operated, and 10 actively managed and which meets the requirements of section 11 15.102, subsection 5, paragraph "a", subparagraphs (1) through 12 (3). 13 EXPLANATION 14 This bill changes the definition of targeted small business 15 for purposes of the targeted small business financial 16 assistance program administered by the department of economic 17 development, to include only a small business (one which has 18 either fewer than 20 employees or an average annual gross 19 income of less than \$3 million over the preceding three years) 20 which is 51 percent or more owned, operated, and actively 21 managed by minority or female individuals.
