1 Section 1. Section 321.384, subsection 1, Code 1995, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. Every A motor vehicle operated upon a highway within
4 the this state, shall display lighted headlamps as provided in
5 section 321.415 at any time from sunset to sunrise, at any
6 time when the windshield wipers are in operation, and at such
7 other times when conditions such as fog, snow, sleet, or rain
8 provide insufficient lighting to render clearly discernible
9 persons and vehicles on the highway at a distance of five
10 hundred feet ahead, ~~shall display lighted head lamps as~~
11 ~~provided in section 321.415,~~ subject to exceptions with
12 respect to parked vehicles as hereinafter stated.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill requires that a motor vehicle must display
15 lighted headlights at any time when the vehicle's windshield
16 wipers are in operation. A violation of this provision
17 carries a scheduled fine of \$20.
