A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to work performance of certain supervisory
2 positions in the department of human services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 2122

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 217.45 SUPERVISORY STAFF
2 REQUIREMENTS.

3 For the purposes of this section, "supervisory staff
4 person" means a department of human services supervisory staff
5 person who supervises individual department staff members who
6 maintain a caseload of individuals, contracts, or functions
7 which directly implement the department's services. The term
8 does not apply to the director of human services, division
9 administrators, and bureau chiefs. For a period of thirty or
10 more continuous calendar days in every two fiscal years, a
11 supervisory staff person shall maintain at least the average
12 of the minimum caseload required of the persons supervised by
13 the supervisory staff person.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill applies to department of human services
16 supervisors of staff persons who maintain a caseload of
17 individuals, contracts, or functions which directly implement
18 the department's services. The requirement does not apply to
19 the director of human services, division administrators, and
20 bureau chiefs. The bill requires a supervisor to maintain a
21 caseload which is as least the average of the minimum caseload
22 required of the staff members supervised by the supervisor.
23 The caseload must be maintained for a period of at least 30
24 continuous calendar days in every two fiscal years.

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
